As an Adventure Instructor, you'll play a vital role in leading and mentoring students during these field-based programs. Your responsibilities will include planning and facilitating activities, teaching outdoor skills, managing logistics, and ensuring the safety and well-being of participants. Adventure Instructors also support program logistics and equipment management, making this a dynamic and impactful role.

Primary Responsibilities

- Supervise and mentor up to 18 students during 7- to 14-day adventures in frontcountry and backcountry settings.
- Teach outdoor living skills, including packing, camp setup and takedown, outdoor cooking, orienteering, and risk management.
- Lead activities such as rock climbing, fishing, archery, riflery, blacksmithing, rafting, horseback riding, canoeing, and backpacking.
- Develop and teach age-appropriate curricula that emphasize leadership and environmental education.
- Document course progress, provide feedback, and engage in post-trip evaluations.
- Maintain and organize gear storage, repair equipment as needed, and ensure readiness for trips.
- Implement trip logistics, including schedules, routes, emergency plans, and menus.
- Administer first aid, student health screenings, and medications as required.
- Support meal preparation, cleanup, and other camp operations during programs.
- Capture and submit photos and videos that reflect the participant experience.

Expectations and Workload

- Work 6-7 days per week with one or more days off between sessions. Regularly work extended hours, including being on-call 24/7 for student needs during trips.
- Carry packs weighing up to 60 pounds and hike challenging terrain.

• Drive a 15-passenger van with a trailer and complete van and trailer safety training.

Professional Performance Standards

- Maintain high professional standards in appearance, demeanor, and performance, serving as a role model for participants.
- Contribute positively to the Camp GROW community through teamwork, creativity, and problem-solving.
- · Adhere to organizational policies, safety protocols, and risk management practices.
- Demonstrate a commitment to personal and professional growth, cultural sensitivity, and fostering an inclusive environment.

Required Qualifications

- Experience leading or guiding participants in backcountry settings.
- Prior experience working with school-age children.
- Ability to teach one or more of the following: horsemanship, riflery, archery, rock climbing, swimming, canoeing, fishing, ecology, or arts and crafts.
- CPR certification or the ability to obtain certification before employment.
- Ability to lift 50 pounds and hike steep terrain with gear.
- Must be 18 years or older and pass a comprehensive background check.

Preferred Qualifications

- Current Wilderness First Aid (WFA)
- Lifeguard certification.
- Experience with paddleboarding, horsemanship, or outdoor recreation.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office, Adobe software, or other digital tools.
- Experience driving with a trailer and familiarity with backcountry travel.

Work Environment

Adventure Instructors work closely with their teammates in a high-energy, collaborative environment. Programs may involve challenging physical activities, inclement weather, and exposure to high-alpine conditions. Staff will also travel to off-site program locations, with most transportation provided by Camp GROW.
